

## TRANSPLANT SELECTION CRITERIA

### Pediatric Intestinal Transplantation

#### Inclusion Criteria

- Irreversible intestinal failure with associated life threatening complications such as
  - Loss of vascular access
  - One or more episodes of vascular access sepsis
  - Elevation of liver function tests

#### Absolute Exclusion Criteria

- Psychosocial instability of care provider that would interfere with compliance
- Severe psychiatric impairment which would interfere with ability of care provider to understand informed consent and compliance with therapeutic regimen
- Severe neurological impairment
- Active systemic infection
- Active cancer
- Severe cardiovascular disease
- Active alcohol, narcotic abuse or illicit drug use
- Absence of funding for the transplant procedure and/or medications post-transplant
- Pregnancy

#### Possible Exclusion Criteria

- Chronic Pulmonary Disease necessitating oxygen supplementation or mechanical ventilation
- HIV (patients will be referred to a center specializing in HIV positive transplant procedures)
- History of Cancer - The Israel Penn International Transplant Tumor Registry (IPITTR) will be consulted on an individual basis regarding recommendations for waiting time prior to transplant consideration

## **TRANSPLANT SELECTION CRITERIA**

### **Adult Intestinal Transplantation**

#### **Inclusion Criteria**

- Irreversible intestinal failure with associated life threatening complications such as

- Severe psychiatric impairment which would interfere with ability to understand informed consent and medical compliance
- Severe neurological impairment
- Active systemic infection
- Active cancer
- Severe cardiovascular disease
- Active alcohol, narcotic abuse or illicit drug use
- Absence of funding for the transplant procedure and/or medications post-transplant
- Pregnancy
